

NEW LICENSE STRUCTURE OFFERS SPORTSMEN *NEW OPTIONS AND NEW WAYS TO SAVE*

New License Options

■ Multi-Year Licenses

Offers hunters and anglers an opportunity to hunt and fish longer *and* save money.

2-year Hunting License - \$18 (An annual hunting license is \$10)

2-year Fishing License - \$16 (An annual fishing license is \$9)

■ Combo Licenses

Convenient, new 2-year and 3-day Hunting & Fishing Combo License saves money.

2-year Hunting & Fishing Combo License - \$31 (An annual combo license is \$17)

3-day Hunting & Fishing Combo License - \$3.50 (Previous 1-day hunting and fishing license was \$3.50; 3-day combo includes fishing privileges on WMAs and PFAs)

■ Apprentice License

Offers potential hunters (16 years of age and older) an opportunity to hunt for 3 days without completing a hunter education course. Also includes fishing privileges on WMAs and PFAs.

■ Stacking Licenses

For those planning to hunt or fish for years to come, stacking is a great new option.

Sportsmen can purchase multiple annual or multi-year licenses and "stack" them into one transaction – saving money and eliminating multiple service charges. **Note:** Not all licenses can be stacked, if you have questions, visit georgiawildlife.com or call 1-800-366-2661.

Other Ways to Save

■ Early Renewal Discount

An easy way to save! The majority of hunting and fishing licenses offer sportsmen an early renewal option with a savings of \$2.75 when a same privilege license is purchased before expiration of the old license.

■ Reduced Sportsman's License Cost

Under the new license structure, sportsmen save \$5 annually (\$55/year compared to \$60/year) when purchasing this license which covers all hunting and fishing privileges including Hunting, Big Game, WMA, Georgia Waterfowl Conservation, Fishing and Trout Licenses and the H.I.P. Permit (excludes the Deer Dog License, Alligator License and Federal Duck Stamp).

■ Elimination of Primitive Weapons License – *savings for residents & non-residents!*

Beginning with the 2009-2010 hunting season, hunters are no longer required to purchase a separate Primitive Weapons License. This is an annual savings of \$8 for residents and \$25 for non-residents.
