- **Campers:** Maximum of 20 campers, ages 13-17.

- **Our base camp:** Epworth by the Sea (www.epworthbythesea.org), a retreat and conference center located on the Frederica River.
- **Chaperones:** Four chaperones (2 male, 2 female) will provide 24 hour supervision.
- **Housing:** Campers will stay in one large cabin divided into two rooms, each with 10 bunk beds. Boys and girls will be in separate rooms with chaperone quarters located in between. Campers will need to bring sleeping bags/bedding and linens. (Packing list located in camp packet.)
- **Meals:** All meals will be provided by Epworth by the Sea, including box lunches for our daily field trips. Special diets are easily accommodated.
- **Recreation:** Epworth has a swimming pool, with lifeguard on duty, as well as playing fields for other recreational activities.
- **Camp Director:** Julie Duncan – GA-DNR Wildlife Interpretive Specialist and director for The Outdoor Discovery School at Charlie Elliott Wildlife Center.
