

How to Interpret the Quota Hunt Tables

The following information provides an explanation of the selection information contained within the Quota Hunt Tables. The information below is provided as an explanation of each column heading.

The information below applies to **Deer, Turkey, Waterfowl, and Alligator** hunts (State Park hunts are not included at this time due to the fact that this hunt type has just become a priority-based for the upcoming season).

HUNT NUMBER – This is simply the number assigned to the hunt as it appears in the regulations book.

WMA – This is the specific Wildlife Management Area that hosts the hunt.

QUOTA – This is how many hunters are permitted to participate in the hunt.

TOTAL APPS (1ST CHOICE) – This column has two numbers. The first number is the total of all hunters that selected the hunt either as their 1st, 2nd or 3rd choice. The second number, which is in parentheses, is the number of hunters that selected the hunt as their 1st choice.

SELECTION ODDS FOR 1ST CHOICE BY PRIORITY (# OF 1ST CHOICE APPS) – The columns contained in this section are broken out by the number of priority points the hunter assigned to their application. The first number is the percentage (%) of all applicants that chose the hunt as their 1st choice and were selected. The second number, which is in parentheses, is the total number of hunters that chose the hunt as their 1st choice. This selection information has been broken into applications with a priority of three or greater (**P3 OR >**), applications with priority of two (**P2**), applications with priority of one (**P1**), and applications without priority (**P0**). If there is no information in a given box, then there were no 1st choice applications for the hunt at the particular priority level.

The information below applies only to **Alligator** hunts.

ZONE – This column lists the Alligator Zone where a selected hunter is permitted to harvest an alligator. A map of the Alligator Zones is provided in the Hunting Regulations section of our website.
